SPECIAL NOTE: All students should be prepared for a Training Emergency Recall at any time following the completion of Day 1 training. This Scenario will be conducted at the discretion of the Instructor Cadre with approval and coordination of Training Staff. This drill proves extremely valuable in the development of Team cohesion, stress inoculation and critical thinking in stressful conditions.
