- ❖ This 5-Day Pistol, Shotgun Instructor Course will qualify students as firearms instructors specializing in semi-automatic pistols/revolvers, pump-action / semi-automatic shotguns.
- ❖ Students will receive a certificate of certification valid for 2 years upon successful completion of the course.

CLOTHING

Students should dress according to weather conditions. Recommended that students wear comfortable “tactical” style clothing (i.e. tactical pants, lightweight breathable shirt)

AMMUNITION REQUIREMENTS

SHOTGUN:

- 12 Gauge Buckshot (9 pellet)
- 12 Gauge Slug (1oz)

HANDGUN:

- Semi auto pistol - 9mm, .40, .45
- Revolver - .357 Magnum, .38 Special

- Shotgun sling
- Handgun Duty Holster
- Duty Belt
- Ear protection, Eye Protection, Ballcap
- Cleaning equipment for each weapon
